



## TECHNICIAN AND TECHNOLOGIST PROFILES

Technician	Technologist
<p><b>Profile</b></p> <p>Works under general supervision and <b>exercises independent judgement</b> in a specialized practice within a field of engineering or applied science technology.</p> <p>Examines assignments, objectives, and instructions to select procedures and actions to resolve the assigned problem.</p> <p><b>Work generally routine, typical or standardized</b>, but involving choice of action, within limits defined by standard practice and instructions (ie. government regulations or municipal policies).</p> <p>Requires application of various established rules and procedures and decisions that may affect quality, accuracy or utility of results to some degree.</p> <p><b>Work under direction or independently and follows established practice and clear-cut policy in performing majority of duties.</b> Make decisions when general instructions established methods and clearly defined precedents indicate action to be taken but <b>refers unusual problems to superiors.</b></p> <p>May supervise, train, and coordinate the work of others.</p>	<p><b>Profile</b></p> <p><b>Carries out a wide range of complex work</b>, either independently or under general direction.</p> <p>Evaluates assignments, determines and develops procedures and implements solutions, schedules work to meet objectives, participates in short- and long-range planning, and may become involved in developing and promoting conceptual change.</p> <p><b>Work is <u>not generally routine</u>, but instead semi-routine or diversified.</b> Requires judgement in the application of broader aspects of established practices and procedures to problems and situations not falling clearly or concisely within the limitations of accepted standards or precedents.</p> <p><b>Work independently on broad general assignments with responsibility for all planning of work, limited only by company policy. Make major decisions without reference to superiors</b>, except when large investments or long-term programs are involved.</p> <p>May assume managerial or administrative responsibility for the work of others.</p>
